

Scholarship Criteria & Application

The Association of Oklahoma General Contractors (AOGC) funds scholarships annually for students pursuing a career in road and bridge construction in Oklahoma. Eligible students are enrolled in an Oklahoma four-year university construction program or a two-year Oklahoma institution construction program.

Eligibility:

1. Must be a freshman going into their second year at an Oklahoma two-year program, or student must be at least a sophomore at a 4-year university accepted into a construction program at an Oklahoma university their junior year.
2. Student must be pursuing course work in construction or construction-related engineering.
3. Student must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.
4. Applicant must be a U.S. citizen or documented permanent resident of the U.S. (must possess a “Permanent resident” card) or a student on a visa to the U.S. (must be able to present current visa).
5. Junior and senior-level students must have one full academic year of coursework remaining at the time of the application deadline. **Students must be enrolled in full-time coursework for each semester or trimester for the school year of application.**

Requirements:

1. Applicants are responsible for ensuring all the following items are submitted at www.webuildoklahoma.com by midnight CST by **March 31, 2023**.
 - a. Completed Application
 - b. Unofficial transcript of completed college work to date, or high school transcript for those applying to a 2-year institution. (Official transcript required should a student be selected to receive a scholarship)
 - c. Students are welcome to attach any letters of recommendation from professors; however, they are not required.
 - d. Incomplete application packages will not be considered.
2. All applicants selected as finalists will be required to participate in a personal interview.
3. Students are heavily encouraged to participate in AOGC activities. Participation at meetings, lunches, site visits, internships and/or volunteering at scholarship fundraisers will be considered.
4. Award recipients will be required to attend a lunch to receive the award in May.
5. The student will also be required to attend the AOGC Annual Safety Banquet held in mid-November.

Awards:

1. Students will be required to apply each year of eligibility.
2. Applicants will be reviewed and selected by the AOGC Scholarship Committee.
3. Scholarship winners will be notified of award by April 31, 2023.
4. Scholarship check will be sent directly to student’s institution bursar’s office.
5. Awards will be determined by Scholarship Committee, per semester, or trimester.
